2018 Group Program Guidelines

Registration Process

Please fill out the provided registration forms in their entirety and drop them off at 3 Spruce Ave, fax to 780-640-9404, or email to familysupport@robinhoodassoc.com. Registration is based on a first come, first serve basis, and is contingent on staff availability. **All master file documents must be current, including FSCD contract, in order for clients to attend programs.** You will be emailed any documents that need to be updated. Confirmation will be provided via email as soon as staffing is secured.

Activities and Program Costs

All children are expected to participate in the scheduled activity or outing. Please ensure your child is appropriately dressed for the activity. If you do not want your child to participate in the scheduled activity, please do not register them for the group. The cost of the group will be listed on the registration form; these fees are non-negotiable and will be billed electronically at the end of each month. Families must be registered for Automatic Debit Withdrawal/ EFT with the Association. Group fees are subject to change but parents will be notified before being billed.

Staffing Support

Staffing support will be billed directly to FSCD and/or approved alternate funding source at a rate of \$13.57 per hour for Shared Support, \$23.51 per hour for level 1 Individual Support and \$29.32 per hour for level 2 Individual Support. Any funds not covered through FSCD or approved alternate funding source will be billed directly to parents. Parents are required to sign a Verification of Services Form. If the form is unsigned, parents will be billed directly for services.

Cancellation Policy

Once confirmed for the group, cancellations must be made by parents with 24 hours notice before the group. As FSCD will not pay for services that were not actually provided, any cancelled days with less than 24 hours notice and unattended days (no shows) will be billed directly to the parents, which will include the cost of any prepaid admissions. Please note that sick days are considered unattended days.

Participant Behaviour and Conduct

The Association will work collaboratively to support the participants and to promote positive behavior. Should there be a situation where behaviors are beyond the staff's capabilities, parents will be required to pick up their child from the group immediately.

Medication

Please remember that all medication to be administered during group program must adhere to Robin Hood's medication policy: **"All medications must come in a properly labeled prescription bottle or bubble pack. A medication form must be signed by the parent or guardian for any medications to be administered"** If your child requires any medication during program hours (self-administered or staff-administered) please fill out the attached medication form. PRN medications (any medication given occasionally based on symptom, such as nausea, headache, etc) are to be provided on the second page of the medication form.

Medication cannot be given if policy is not followed
