RE: RHA Important Update

Dear RHA membership, families/guardians and staff,

A recent letter dated October 26, 2020 from Dr. Deena Hinshaw Re: Rising COVID-19 Case Numbers and Safe Visiting Policy (CMOH Order 29-2020) was written to express concern with respect to the rising COVID-19 in our region and for operators (RHA) to reassess each of our site Safe Visiting Policy, she recommends:

- Only those visiting persons identified as designated family/support persons (and others in extenuating circumstances) are permitted to visit residents within the site.
- [We have been encouraged] to speak to designated family/support persons right away and ask that they evaluate their own need to be physically present (based on the resident need), to help in limited the amount of people entering [our] site.
- We will continue to support virtual options to connecting with residents.
- Our residential program supervisors will be conducting Risk Tolerance Assessments in our homes this week which will be reviewed with families in the very near future. When discussions occur, I encourage all parties to discuss this message and the reflective actions that we can take with rising COVID-19 cases in our region to reduce the risk to individuals and staff in the organization.

Once again, I thank you for your commitment and willingness to abide by the orders and recommendations provided to us. **Currently RHA has no outbreak sites in any homes and/or facilities.** This is impressive as the containment strategies and ongoing tireless efforts of our staff have helped to stop the spread of this virus. I applaud the commitment and dedication of staff who continue to go over and above to ensure the safety of those they support.
