Program Overview

Family Support services provides services to families and their children within Strathcona County and Fort Saskatchewan. This program provides services to individuals from birth to 18 with various disabilities.

Our team consists of 1 director, 1 coordinator and 3 CDP's along with over 100 relief CDW's

Family Support Services key staffing requirements should include but are not limited to:

Due to the diversity of the needs of the families, shifts will vary. Most of the staffing requests are for evening and weekend work. All our CDW positions are casual/relief.

Staff within Family Support would ideally have a valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle with proper liability insurance. The staff would need to be confident in working independently within family's homes and as part of a team at group programs. Staff are not required to have secondary education in the field but it is an asset. Staff need to take initiative and show leadership through play. Staff need to be able to adapt to the unique needs of the families and their children; flexibility is key. Staff also need to have access to email and be able to book and manage their own shifts and accurately complete and submit paperwork on time.
