

Impacts of New Provincial Restrictions

Dear Staff/Individuals/Family/Guardians,

The new restrictions implemented across our communities in Alberta poses new challenges and operational stresses for RHA. The most significant impact is due to the announcement of Alberta school in person learning closures, until May 25, 2021. As a result, the loss of RHA staff staying home because of childcare/online schooling is real for RHA and **may limit** the level of services we will be able to maintain over the next couple of weeks. At this time though, we believe we have enough staffing resources, therefore we will proceed with the reopening of both the Broadway and Broadmoor Day Programs on Monday May 10, 2021 as planned.

We will work with family/guardians/individuals to identify those who require/choose services to be maintained during this time, our services and supports are essential for many of you and we will strive to safely operate to minimize any further service disruptions.

Where RHA can maintain services, we will. If we do not have staffing to reliably support Programs & Services, only then will RHA reach out to those that could be affected to discuss service impacts.

Due to higher risk of Covid-19 exposure in our communities, individuals living in a RHA residential home who have regular scheduled programs at RHA Broadway, Broadmoor or Fort Saskatchewan Day Programs will not be attending these facilities for the next couple of weeks (May 10 – 24, 2021), helping to limit the cross over from RHA Day Programs and Residences.
